Is copying songs legal or not? How do songwriters get paid for their work? respect ©copy|right! offers teachers and schoolchildren an exciting, creative and professionally prepared lesson with playfully conveyed information and guidance on copyright issues. A well-known young artist or rapper will show you how copyright problems can be positively and constructively handled. What is a work? How do you become an artist? The artist and a copyright expert will explain everything you ever wanted to know about these topics. You will discuss questions like

- What about royalties for lyrics, music and pictures on the internet?
- Are you allowed to download lyrics, music and pictures from the internet and pass them on to others?

The artist/rapper will work with the audience to develop the lyrics for a new rap which will then be put to music and sung together with the audience. There is also a competition and a quiz with pictures, texts and music to encourage the audience to participate actively.

The artist will talk about his work and how he earns his living; he will explain the implications of illegal downloading and the legal, social and personal consequences.
