COPYRIGHT REQUESTS DURING PANDEMIC

- DALRO has seen an influx of applications for copyright clearance from tertiary institutions during the pandemic.
- The common issue they have been faced with is not being able to access study materials from home due to the lockdown restrictions.
- To curb this, Universities decided it would be best to make electronic copies of books available on their online platforms for students to access.
- As a result of that, DALRO has been receiving applications for copyright clearance that well exceed our licensing rules of 10% of a published book, or a book chapter.

DALRO's RESPONSE TO THE CHALLENGE

- Sometime before the lockdown was officially announced, DALRO and PASA devised a plan to assist Universities during the challenging times of the pandemic.
- The plan was for publishers to assist by granting special permissions to users designed specifically for the period of the pandemic.
- Though PASA publishers were on board, some non-PASA publishers have declined these “over the threshold” requests.
- This decision has assisted the Universities greatly during this crisis.

DALRO/PASA Measures on affected materials

- Ancillary materials usually made available to lecturers.
- Printed materials not available digitally that universities need to digitise now for access on secure networks of the University.
- Digital materials available under a restricted University wide licence that need to be accessible remotely.

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

- The two previous slides represent an application for copyright clearance from SANTS PRIVATE HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION.
- They requested to use 52.2% of the following title: “TEACHING ENGLISH AS A FIRST ADDITIONAL LANGUAGE IN THE FOUNDATION PHASE: PRACTICAL GUIDELINES”,
- ISBN:978-0-7021-8874-9
- Published by Juta

RESPONSE

- DALRO forwarded the request to publisher on behalf of the institution
- The response from the publisher was swift and permission was granted to the user (institution).
- DALRO then proceeded to generate a quote for the institution.
- This is just one of many examples of the requests DALRO has been handling during the pandemic.

CONCLUSION

- The decision taken by PASA in conjunction with DALRO to grant special permissions to Universities during the pandemic has proven to be of great assistance.
- DALRO are still receiving copyright requests, often with increased volumes, in terms of the pages and copies required by Universities
- DALRO has remained operational during the pandemic albeit remotely.
